IPST Young Scientist Award

The IPST Steering Committee Meeting held in Seoul, June 27, 2017, established an award for young scientists.

- 1. *Eligibility*: To be eligible for the IPST Young Scientist Award (YSA), a candidate must satisfy the following conditions:
- a. The candidate has to be 35 years old and under. If the candidate is a PhD student, then she/he can be older than 35 years old.
- b. The candidate has to attend the IPST conference and give the presentation.
- c. The candidate has to be the first author of the paper.
- d. The candidate cannot be a past recipient of the IPST YSA.

YSA Committee: An YSA Committee is organized for each edition of IPST. The YSA Committee is composed of one of the Steering Committee Co-Chairpersons and the two Technical Program Committee Chairpersons.
